Stewarding –

Stewards will be required in the RCYC in Crosshaven to direct traffic & trailers on Fri evening & Sat – day & evening. Some Stewards will also be needed in Monkstown & the Lapps Quay area on the Sat to direct participants and the viewing public.

Shore safety Points –

Shore Safety points are set up in Crosshaven, Monkstown, Passage & Blackrock. Shore safety monitors the boats from the shore & deals with any crew who are required to come ashore during the course of the race. Shore safety crews will consist of 2 to 3 people at each point and may stand down after the race has passed their station and they have been relieved by the Race Safety Controller.

Launch & Recovery –

Launch takes place in Crosshaven on Sat morning & involves assisting crews to launch their boats in the water – the race is due to start at 10.30am (approx) and boats will begin launching approx 1 hour before start time).

Recovery will take place on Albert Quay East and will be assisted by a crane. Recovery will begin at approx 1.15pm and finishes when the last boat has been recovered (approx 5pm)

Crew Registration –

Crews are registered in the Dinghy centre in RCYC on the Friday evening (from 4pm till 8 pm approx) and on day of the race (from approx 7am until 10am). Crews arriving in Lapps Quay must be de-registered & given their certificates (from approx 2pm till 6pm).

Other areas where we need willing volunteers include –

Merchandise Sales, Kayak Recovery, Market Research, Youth Race, Set-up & take down of barriers, banners & posters etc.

Volunteers will be provided with a volunteer t-shirt, an Ocean to City mug and a packed lunch on the day.
